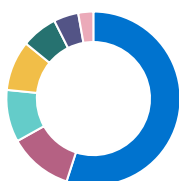

The Risk and Reward Indicator table demonstrates where the Fund ranks in terms of its potential risk and return, calculated using the volatility of monthly returns over five years. As it is based upon how the Fund has performed in the past, you should note that the Fund may well perform differently in the future. The Fund is ranked at 5 reflecting observed historical returns. The fund is in this category because it has shown higher levels of volatility historically.
