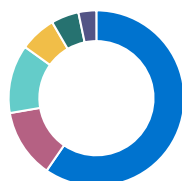

The Risk and Reward Indicator table demonstrates where the Fund ranks in terms of its potential risk and return, calculated using the volatility of monthly returns over five years. The Fund is ranked at 5 reflecting observed historical returns. The fund is in this category because it has shown higher levels of volatility historically.
