We are writing as a group of investors, companies, industry associations, and consumer groups to applaud the Government's decision to include a specific net zero and carbon budget objective as part of Ofgem's mandate via the Energy Bill. We are also keen to underline our support for the Government to move quickly to equip Ofgem to deliver on its new mandate, following the approval of the Energy Bill.

To decarbonise our power, heating, and transport systems, Ofgem needs to plan for and incentivise investment in a net zero future. Connections of renewable energy projects to the grid are facing huge delays which threaten the UK's ability to maximise the use of even existing renewables power generation, and the UK's ability to meet its own target of 50GW of offshore wind by 2030, 70GW solar by 2035. By updating Ofgem's mandate to incorporate the UK's net zero target, the Government will empower the regulator to address the interlocking challenges of the climate emergency, the increasing cost of living, and energy security.

In light of the magnitude of the task facing Ofgem, as soon as the Energy Bill comes into force, we would urge the Government to move quickly to ensure that Ofgem has sufficient capacity, resources, and technical expertise to deliver its revised mandate. The simultaneous finalisation of the long-awaited Strategy and Policy Statement for Ofgem would also be welcome.

Ofgem's effective implementation of its net zero mandate will help to unlock vital investment in the low-cost, low-carbon energy system we are all working towards. The sooner the new regulatory system is up and running, the better.
